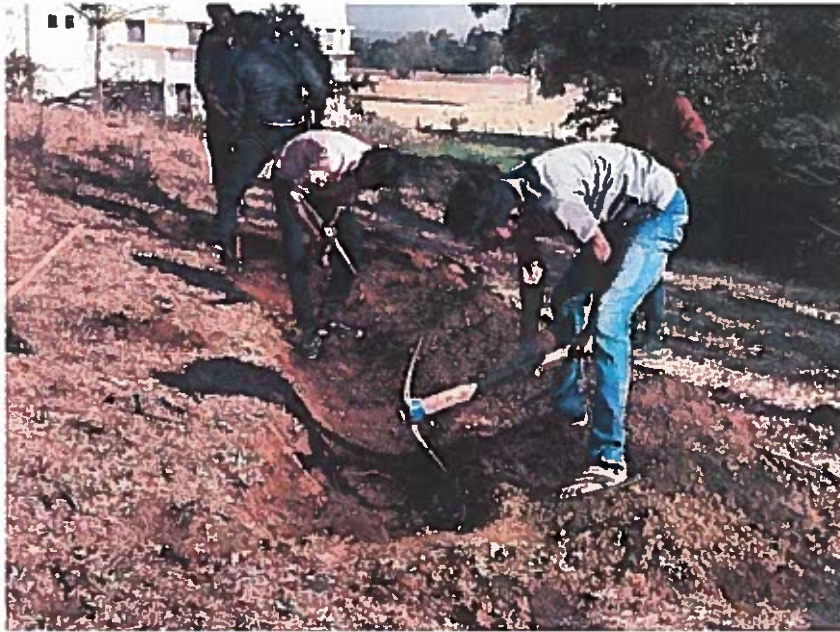
Conclusion:
