#### Introduction

National Service Scheme (NSS) special camp conducted by the NSS unit of KCT's Late G. N. Sapkal College of Engineering at Village Kachurli, in Trimbakeshwar Taluka. During this camp, NSS volunteers organized and executed a unique project involving wall paintings for awareness in the village. 
