Details of Participants: Female = 30 Male = 37 Total = 67

Present around the Network-2024, (PATN-2024) is the IET supported presentation competition for students aged 18 to 30. Competitors are asked to give a presentation for 10 minutes on a subject related to engineering and technology, and to answer questions for a further five minutes. The event is mainly to judge presentation skills, although the topic was appropriate to the intended audience of students and young professionals. The prizes are Rs.15000 for the winner and Rs.10000 for the runner-up, subject to there being four or more competitors.

As per IET rules the presentation room has a raised platform, with a microphone system for the speakers. A laptop and video projector is provided as per standard. The judge were provided with a brief synopsis of the competitors' presentations. As per rules there were three judges who assessed the presentations and then they decided whom to award the positions of winner and runner-up.

During each presentation, the chair indicates the time after eight minutes and then again after ten minutes. The speaker then finishes the presentation as quickly as possible. If necessary, the chair will interrupt the speaker and ask them to stop immediately. The event was conducted for a full day. The event was co-ordinated by Prof. H R Kulkarni. All faculty members from co-ordinated in making this event successful. Students from all discipline and all classes participated in the event.

Prof R N Baji briefed all the participants about the rules and regulations of the event. Prof Mrs Baji, Prof More and Prof Talmale judged the students presentations. The event was concluded with vote of thanks By Prof H R Kulkarni.
