Around 50 students & staff members from Department of Computer Engineering were present for the seminar.



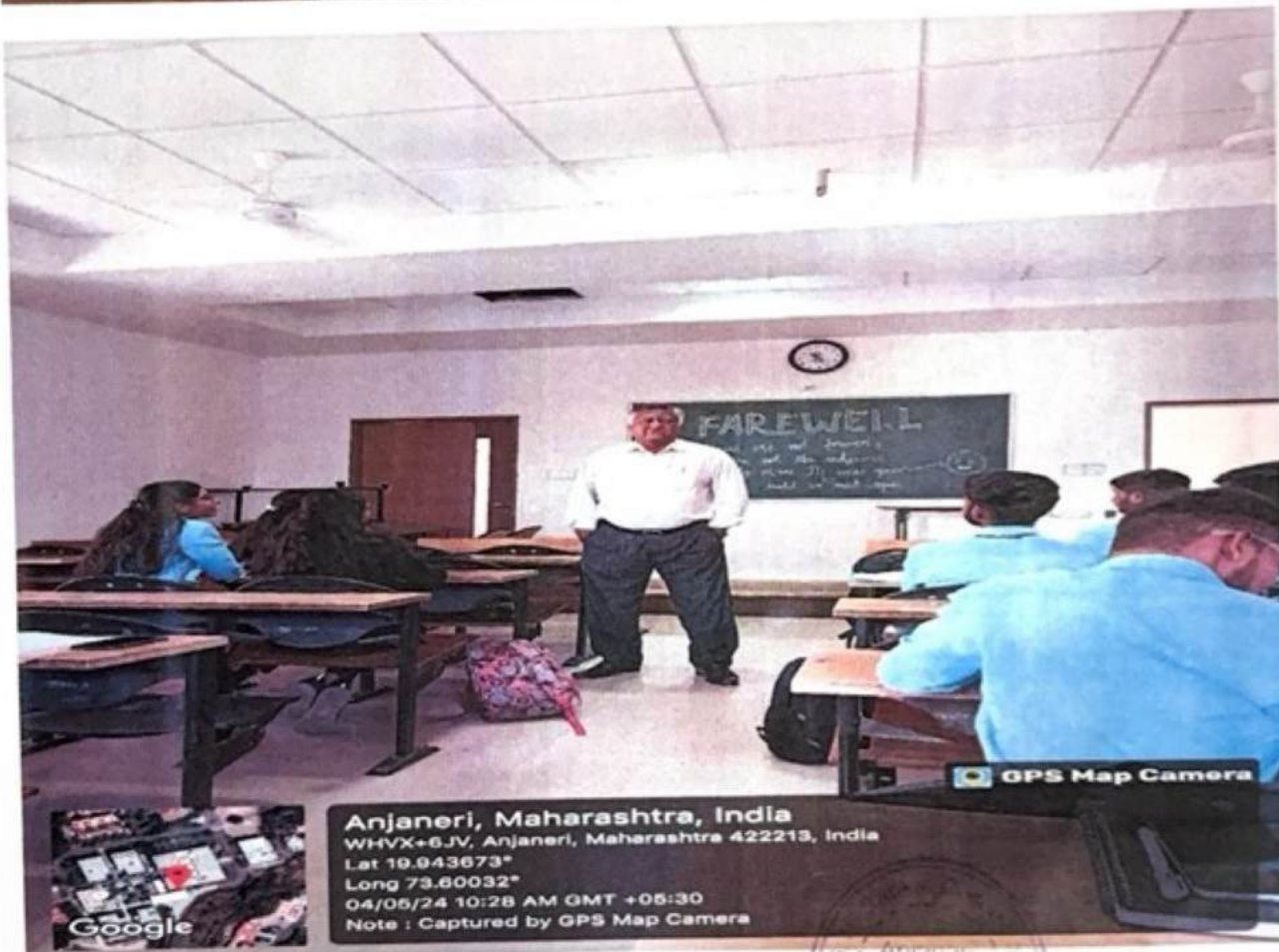
