Summary of the Program:

2. **Abstract** having 100 words (Times New Roman)
3. Participants should **not** include their name, guide name, department and college name on the poster.
4. Winners should be taken further for **Zonal Level Competition**.
5. The project work will be evaluated on the following parameters: -
 - a. Relevance of the Topic
 - b. Methodology adopted (economical and sustainable approach)
 - c. Efforts of the participants
 - d. Novelty/ Innovation of the Project
 - e. Outcome of project work
 - f. Affordability of the project.

The Civil Engineering Departments' drawing hall was beautifully decorated to honor the competition. All the participants, project guides and dignitaries including jury members and Principal gathered in the Drawing Hall at 10.30 a.m on 25/09/2023.
